Note*:

Please ensure that your teams have the proper software, firmware and robot programs PRE-INSTALLED in your laptops or mindstorm controllers prior to quarantine. Teams will not be allowed to download any software or programs wirelessly once they are in quarantine.

Teams are to also ensure that they have brought along with them their laptops (with chargers), laptop login details, miscellaneous tools, and any spare parts or accessories. Passing or exchanging of such items between the teams or with anyone outside the quarantine area will not be allowed.

Each team is only allowed to bring 1 laptop and to be used strictly for programming purpose. Additional materials for presentation can be kept by teachers or trainers until presentation time. Teams will start off with the robot game before proceeding with their presentation.

MOBILE PHONES, THUMBDRIVES, COMMUNICATION DEVICES and Presentation/Visual Materials are strictly NOT allowed within the quarantine area. Teachers or Team Managers will have to be responsible for the safekeeping of such items before the team enter. The organiser holds no responsibilities for the loss of items.

Participants can bring some light snacks into the quarantine area. However, they are expected to clear their own rubbish before leaving. Only mineral/plain water is allowed in the quarantine area.

Participants are allowed to leave the competition grounds upon completion of both Robot Game and Presentation.

The Organiser reserves the right to amend or adjust the competition schedule without prior notice.
